*Spain

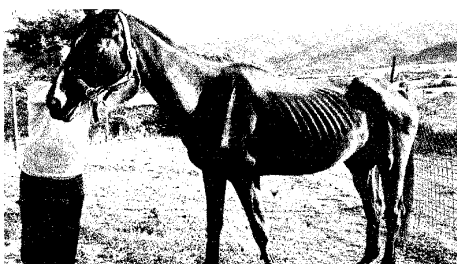
To help buy fencing for a kennel near Benidorm and print leaflets appealing for donations
